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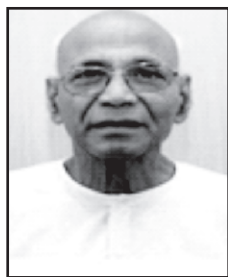

1. Introduction

Inba Seva Sangam (ISS) is situated in the hamlet of Kadavur Panchayat union of Karur District in Tamil Nadu.

Mother Lea Provo

Inba Seva Sangam was established by Mother Lea Provo in 1968 under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act. Mother Lea Provo from Belgium at the instance of a Gandhian disciple Shanthidass (Joseph Jean Lanze del Vasto) of France came to India and visited Gandhian institution in Tamil Nadu and finally established two model villages of Sevapur and Vinobajipuram to serve the rural people in the manner which was suggested by Mahatma Gandhi. Sevapur and Vinobajipuram are not only newly created villages and communes located in a beautiful and quiet natural environment but also places where one can draw inspiration and experience the divine.

The organization ISS having its existence for 52 years serving the people, who live here came from different places, belonged to different castes and religion and believed only in love and service, wanted to create a community with equality and equity and therefore christened the places to be Sevapur and Vinobajipuram. Empowerment of the downtrodden through Education and Economic development is the main objective of Inba Seva Sangam.

According to the President Dr. N. Markandan in his words – “Mother Lea Provo, with her noble mission, visualized with ideal

vision to create a compact, small, rural, and vibrant and Eco – friendly community to enjoy liberty, equality and fraternity by preserving Peace, Strength and Joy among themselves.

ISS has served the rural communities in the Kadavur valley for 52 years started and supported by Mother Lea Provo with her own funds and financial Support provided by her family and friends. However, SAWES, the Belgian non-profit organization was founded in 1984 to support Inba Seva Sangam and has been supporting the efforts of ISS since then. While sharing some thoughts on the occasion of the celebration of the 50 years of existence of Inba Seva Sangam SAWES, they place on record a very profound statement – “We are very thankful that these programs are inspired by the teachings and the life of Mahatma Gandhi and that they still continue in the spirit Mother Lea Provo installed in this region. Those who remember the valley in the days before the arrival of Mother Lea Provo or have seen the pictures of this valley, it is evident that more than one miracle has taken place here in the last 50 years.”

SAWES further articulates that – “SAWES is very thankful for the realizations made by the people of Inba Seva Sangam and the villages of Sevapur and Vinobajipuram. Besides the donor community which supported the cause put forward by Mother Lea Provo, continues to value the efforts of ISS and provides unstinted support in taking forward the mandate with changes in the development context and the new needs that deserve to be addressed. 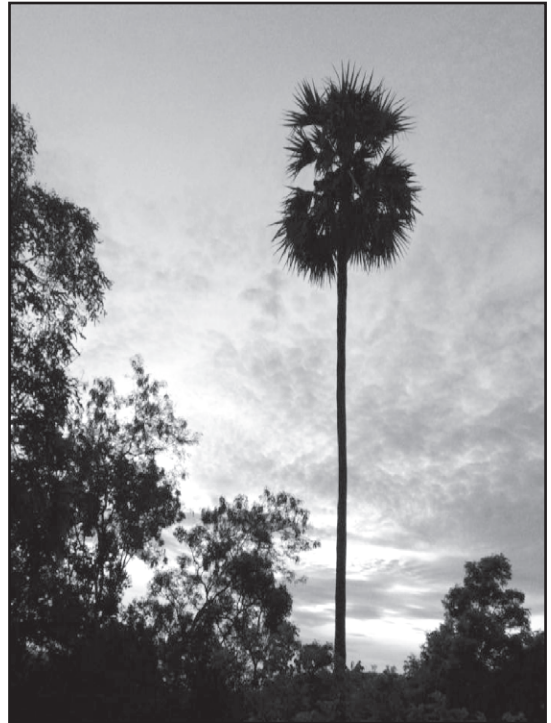

3. Activities:

I. 3.1 Foster Children Scheme- Life Centred Education Under Privileged

The children's program is popularly known as the Foster Children's Scheme (FCS), has been going on since the time of Mother Lea Provo. ISS looks after 269 children out of whom 61 are from socially disadvantaged community. Most of these children are identified by women Self- Help Group members, and also through many requests from poor parents / relatives who come for help. Based on a set of criteria evolved by ISS over the years to identify the needy children, care is taken to reach the children who are genuinely in need of care and Support.

Students Admission:

11 new students enrolled in 6th class in the 2020-21 for FCS Scheme and new student profile also sent to the SAWES, Belgium.

Students Exam Result

18 students wrote the Class 12 examination and 16 students passed during the academic year 2020-21,

Government announced all 10 class students passed because of COVID -19. Hence all our 32 students were promoted.

Major Events for FCS Scheme:

During 25th March -2020 to 7th May 2020 our Tamil Nadu Government announced holiday in view of COVID-19.

We arranged a meeting and discussed. On the maintenance of two hostels, on how many days, how many visit the office and ISS circles, in order to distribute the groceries for our students. We collectively decided and implemented.

During the Covid -19 period we were preparing the Transfer Certificate, Students Records (Admission Register), and getting School related certificates for the renewal of School Building Certificate, Sanitation Certificate and Fire Certificate.

During the Lockdown period we provided groceries to 412 resources less poor students families. We provided some groceries for Sevapur, Vinobajipuram beneficiaries 150 deserving families.

We completed the damaged work for the



school campus and two hostels like Computer lab , basket ball play ground , Class room roof tiles (Oodu) and smokeless Solar Stove & Girls Hostel Roof.

We sent 160 Christmas Greeting letters to foster Parents, SAWES, Belgium. and also sent 6 Pongal greeting letters to local parents & Anil Semiya, Dindigul.

Annai Lea Higher Secondary School

Academic year 2020-21 our Annai Lea School students strength was 179. 10th, 11th, 12th result was 92 %.

This year we prepared the class X, XI, for quarterly, half yearly students answer sheet with rank card submitted to the DEO office.

The students basic details were corrected. (Date of Birth, Admission No, Exam Number) in the website.

The Transfer Certificate was prepared for the students and issued to the students.

Collected text books from the District Educational office. Preparation of Online class teaching aids and lessons were completed.

Teaching Methods for Our School Students

Specific Training to teachers on conducting Class to students through Zoom and usage of Zoom application by Mr.Vijay Khanna Administrative Manager. In turn the teachers will facilitate the students to start use and learn through ZOOM application.

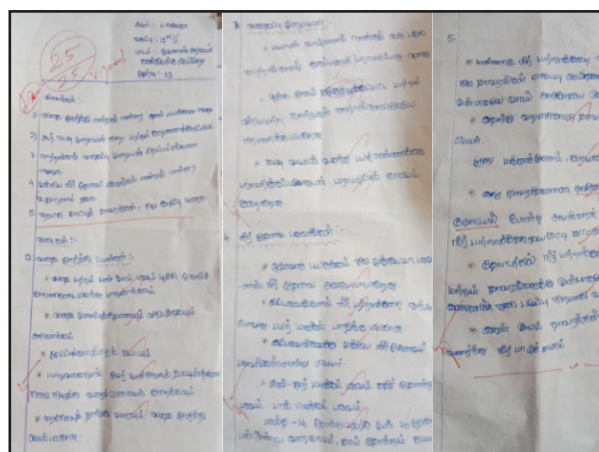

This year we submitted the application for Scholarship to the Department of Social Welfare board for our students.

6th standard Admission was initiated this year and 11 students joined our school.

Teachers Activities during Lockdown :

- ❖ Refreshers training for our school teachers were conducted by Mr. Palanichamy. The same was attended by all the teachers.
- ❖ School Play ground development plan and work has been initiated with a committee of teachers as shramadhan activity.
- ❖ Farming activity was carried out by the teachers in the evening. Follow up of 12th passed out students and helping them to identify college and admission procedures.
- ❖ Online classes for 10th, 11th and 12th classes were conducted by the respective class teachers as per the schedule.
- ❖ Online class, home works and tests were given on the basis of 25 marks per subject and same was sent through the Whatsapp group for correction.



- ❖ On 13.10.2020 the original mark sheets for the 12th standard students were obtained. 22.10.2020 the original mark sheets for 10th standard obtained from the District Education Office at Kulithalai. Attendance and mark registers that were submitted already for the 10th and 11th standard students were obtained from the District Education Office Kulithalai on 28.10.2020.
- ❖ Students who do not have Whatsapp facility were met in person and given



explanations for their doubts.

- ❖ Teachers visited the students who were unable to communicate for a long time such as Karthik Raja, Karuppasamy, Jothimanickam, Chitra, Chinnamani, Vinitha & were interacted and counseled them to continue and concentrate in their studies.
- ❖ Few Students were found working as labourers. The children were identified and rescued through series of negotiations / counseling with parents and teachers, so that the student continue their studies.
- ❖ The teachers went to student's house to collect the feedback from students about the magazine "THUMBI". The opinion of

the teachers were also recorded and sent to the Redington Foundation. The copy received so far was marked on the report.

- ❖ Online classes, home works and tests were given on the basis of 25 marks per subject and the answers were sent back through whatsapp for correction. Corrected answers were reposted by the teachers through the whatsapp group.
- ❖ Preparatory works pertaining to health and safety during COVID 19' were made for the Parent Teacher Meeting on 9.11.2020.
- ❖ Discussion with the parents of 9th to 12th standard students were conducted and follow up with Parents for feedback on 9.11.2020 with regard to reopening of School.

Mr. Muniyandi - HM (I/C) Were selected. Its purpose is to discuss the needs of teachers, ideas, suggestions and the development of the school.

Farm Activities:

- Harvested and sold seasonal mangoes for our school garden Rs.1100/-
- As part of “Shramadhan” activity, this month the teachers took 34 pits additional to previous months work. Planted - “Ribbed Gourd” in the entire pits. Apart from this 12 beds have been raised and the Greens & Tomato seeds were sown in the field and maintained. Process of Bio-Dynamic fertilizers was initiated to use in these fields.

- The herbal garden work previously maintained by the students was carried out by the teachers.
- The herbaceous plants in this garden are Tulasi (*Ocimum sanctum*), Keezhanelli (*Phyllanthus amarus*), Siriyanangai (*Andrographis paniculata*), Omavalli (*Coleus amboinicus*), Kuppaimani (*Acalypha indica*), Ranakalli (*Bryophyllum pinnata*), Manchal Karisalangann (*Weddelia chinensis*), Nithiyakalyani (*Catharanthus roseus*), and Adathota (*Justicia adhatoda*).
- Mobilized manure and ash from OBD AF for composting works. On the same day, the ridge ground vines were fertilized, incinerated, sprayed with pesticides and mulched.





- Sramadhan' is for land preparation for cultivation, sowing seeds and to prepare bio manure "Amrita karaisal" to control pests.

Annai Genetic & Botanical Garden

- * Fencing has done for our Botanical Garden.
- Our BD Students prepared the Nursery bags , maintained herbal plants and cleaned botanical Garden.



- Collected the fire wood from Botanical garden and sold to outside Rs.53,168/-
- Prepared the MOV documents and sent to IMO control through the Trace net.
- Herbal Leafs, Herbal barks, Flowers harvested in genetic garden and sent to Siddha unit for herbal medicine making purpose.

- During the Pandemic Period 2020-21 our siddha unit mostly harvested herbs and stored.
- 42 kgs of tooth powder produced and sold.

Social Education Centre

- ◆ 1.00 acre land paddy planted, maintained and harvested 9 packages.
- ◆ Our Social Education Centre farm has a cow 6 maintained.
- ◆ This year 20 Moringa sapplings planted in garden corner point
- ◆ Submitted Organic Certificate to Tamil Nadu Organic Certification Department.

Organic & Bio-Dynamic Agriculture Farm -OBDAF

- ◆ Harvested Amla fruit and sold to Rs.64,834/- Chennai organic buyers.
- ◆ 5 acres land cleaned and prepare for cultivate and also Burning a 150 Teak Trees.
- ◆ 2 acres land planted the Gerkhin thourgh Organic Method.
- ◆ We Collected fire wood from our farm area and sold for Rs. 9,482/-
- ◆ We are maintained a 11Cows and bulks for our farm. And sold for milk.
- ◆ During year strengthened a fence in our farm both side.
- ◆ 30 Moringa cuttings planed for Our farm field channel area.
- ◆ Mulching and Maintained the Sappotta field.
- ◆ Sowing sorghum seeds 1 acre for Animal husbandry purpose.
- ◆ We planted the some vegetables like Tomato, Brinjal plants. And prepared the 4 tone compost applied for the fields.

Organic & Bio -Dynamic Farming School



Our School of Bio-Dynamic Farm is affiliated with Bharathidasan University. In the year 2020-21, 10 students were studied in Diploma Course this school.



Bio-fertilizer Production and Benefits:

Went to Kurinji Farm in Kodaikanal in March 2021 for a class on Natural Bio-fertilizer Production. There a class on natural bio-fertilizer was taken by Mr. C. Jayakaran. Includes Almanac, Astronomy, Rudolph Steiner Biography, Cow Pat Pit (CPP), Compost (BD Compost), Horn Manure (BD 500), Horn Silica



(BD 501), BD 502 - Yarrow, BD 503 - Chamomile, BD 504 - Sentati, BD 505 - Oak Park, BD 506 - Dandelion, BD 507 - Valerian.

Then Cow Pat Pit (CPP) and Horn Manure (BD 500) were prepared. Horn manure and horn silica manure were then sprayed all over the land as a recipe exercise. The class was attended by Mr.Thangapandian (Joint Secretary of Inba Seva Sangam), Mr. P. Sivalingam (Teacher of Annai Lea Higher Secondary School), Ms. M. Priya (Farm Superintendent of Annai Lea Community College) and also Participated Annai Lea Community College Students.

Soil Science:

Geology class was conducted by Dr. K. Perumal. What is a soil? Soil types, soil functions, topsoil importance, soil layers, natural chemistry and biological properties, soil problems and solutions, acidity, soil protection methods were clearly stated. Soil testing was done with Chromato gram as a recipe exercise.

Irrigation of water facility:

Mr. Thangapandian, Joint Secretary conducted What is drip irrigation? its uses,



functions and methods of use, borehole, drip irrigation, sprinkler irrigation, filters and its maintenance methods, water and irrigation, water collection methods by Mr. Thangapandian (Joint Secretary, Inba Seva Sangam) As suggested by them. Then as a project drip tap is set up in our college and water management is being maintained.

Farm Tools:

Mr. Thangapandian explained our students about Ploughing, Weeding, Harvesting

and Planting. Then all the students learnt about



the parts of the tractor, fitting the parts, ploughing, operating the tractor, operating the bush cutter tool etc. as a recipe exercise.

Seed production:

A session on seed production was conducted by Mr. Sujithi Sakaravarthi . He explained students about Definition of Seed, Seed structure, Internal part of Seed, Seed dormancy, Seed development, Indian seed Industry, Quality of seeds, Seed testing, Seed germination, Seed storage. Seed germination capacity was then tested as a routine exercise.

Agricultural Forestry:

Agricultural Forestry class was taken by



Mr. R. Natrajan. He highlighted the importance of forests, the benefits of various types of agricultural forests, and nursery management. On the last day of the class the Toppaiyasamy trekking took place. He spoke about a variety of evergreen trees, shrubs, plants, herbs, and a variety of birds.

Animal Husbandry :

A session on Animal husbandry was taken by Ms. Priya. She explained clearly about the breeds of goats, chicken and cows, the method of setting up the cowshed, the methods of keeping the zebra, the methods of disease control and the methods of fodder rearing. Two officers and ten students went to Auroville, near Pondicherry, for an animal Husbandry class and stayed at the Vindara farm. Under the guidance of Mr. Krishnan, Dr. Lucas spoke on the history of livestock and parts of livestock the diseases that cows on the Annapurna farm, the diseases that come with cows, Mr. Bernadu and Mrs. Deepika on traditional seeds at Pebble Garden. Mr. Raman also explained about poultry farming in Arrow Orchard.

Skills Training:

Life Development Skills Trainings was conducted by Dr. N. Markandan Ayya, President of Inba Seva Sangam, Spoken English Class, Communication Skill training was conducted Mr. Palanichamy by Mr. Nallayamperumal Ayya.



Other Activities: -



- ❖ Application for admission of students was prepared to be submitted to Bharathiar University.
- ❖ On 04-01-2021 - Students paid Rs.14,500 / - by cheque to Bharathiar University as admission fee.
- ❖ 07-01-2021 - 10 students participated in the 6th batch student admission interview held at the School of Bio-Dynamic School. Held of our Director and Project Officer.
- ❖ On both days 08-01-2021 and 09-01-2021 M. Priya and our students went to Sevapur Head Office, Organic and Wildlife Farm, Annai Lea High School, Siddha Project, and Vanagam.
- 18-01-2021 - 6th Batch 1 Bio Dynamic Training Camp was held at BD School. Inba Seva Sangam President , Secretary , Dr. Davitravindran Ayya, Mr. Nallayamperumal Ayya and Mr. Mani Ayya also participated.
- ❖ 120 kg of Cow Pat Pit is prepared.
- ❖ 2 tone BD- Compost is prepared.
- ❖ 250 liters of Jivamirtham was prepared and given to the crops as growth promoter and mixed with water for irrigation.

- ❖ 10 liters of Panchakavya was prepared and given as a stimulant to the crops.
- ❖ 5 liters of ginger garlic paste was prepared and sprayed on the crops for pest control.
- ❖ During the Year 5 acre of land was ploughed in the summer.
On 12.04.2020 Tapioca was planted in one acre land in our BD-School Area.
- ❖ On 22.05.2020 4.740 kg of horn manure (BD 500) was stored in BD -School. This manure used for the students training in October 2019.



- ❖ 3 acres of land was ploughed during the rainy season and maize and sorghum seeds were sown. Corn husk - 1 tipper, horse gram - 10 kg, horse gram straw - 1 tipper, were harvested.
- ❖ Fodder grass (Thai Napier grass) is planted at 0.25 cents and fed to cows.
Azolla is being produced.



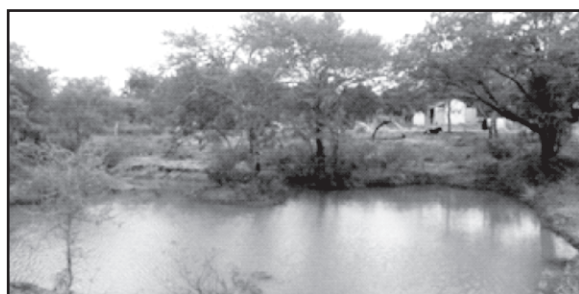
- ❖ Fruit saplings and green maroon saplings are watered and protected.



- ❖ According to the survey this year, 22.5 cm of rainfall was recorded in Vinobajipuram.

Available Livestock Details:

- Cows = Total - 4
- Goat male - 1, Goat female - 3, = Total 6 counts.
- Hens - 3, Cocks - 2, Chicks - 1 = Total number 6



- There are 15 pigeons.

Stopped activities: -

- ❖ Cashew trees fell by tipper by mysterious persons on 27-3-2020. It was stopped and sent to warn them. The leaves were then brought to the school by tipper.
- ❖ A wildfire broke out over a river at the School of Bio Dynamic Farming. It was

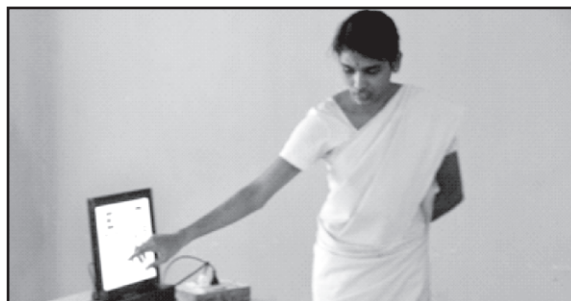
Community outreach programmes - Free Eye Camp

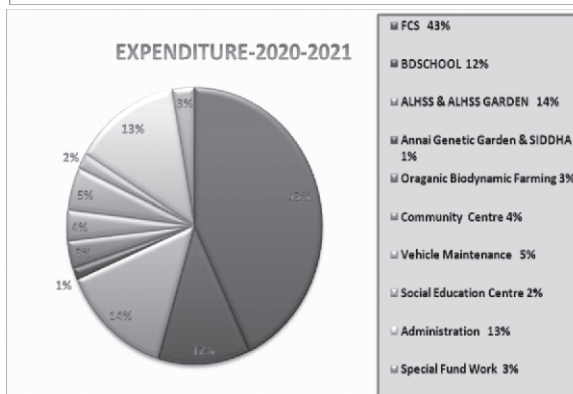
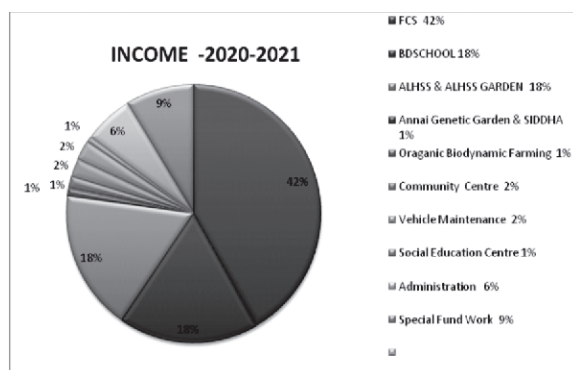

4. Activities

4.1. Foster Children Scheme - Life Centered Education for Under Privileged

The children's program is popularly known as the Foster Children's Scheme (FCS), has been going on since the time of Mother Lea Provo. ISS looks after 269 children out of whom 61 are from socially disadvantaged community. Most of these children are identified by women Self- Help Group members, and also through many requests from poor parents / relatives who come for help. Based on a set of criteria evolved by ISS over the years to identify the needy children, care is taken to reach the children who are genuinely in need of care and Support.

The ISS parent organization SAWES, based in Belgium supports 160 children; and 10 children are sponsored by Indian donors. This year witnessed Nagarajan Roobarani Foundation (Anil Semiya) supporting 6 children, Mr.Ramaiyakumar supporting 3 children, Mr. Nandha Kishore supporting 1 Child and Ms.Annika Karlsson supporting 3 children.

Annai Lea Higher Secondary School :

11 children are studying in the local High School, and 24 children are pursuing their higher studies outside. 102 children staying in Boys Hostel and 85 children are staying in Girls hostel. During weekends these children are taught yoga, tailoring and organic Agriculture.

Girl Children organise the Om Temple Prayers on every Friday and Boys organise the Prayers on Tuesday. Besides the children's representatives are taken to the market once a week for purchase of vegetables so as to ensure that they are exposed to the happenings.

ISS policy is to ensure that the children are equipped with education / training for 2 or 3 years after they complete school, so that they can be employed to take care of themselves and their families when they leave the FCS programmer. Annai Lea Higher Secondary School, Annai Lea Boys and Girls hostel function under the FCS scheme.

FCS Students Particulars

There are 187 children residing at Annai Lea Boys and Girls Hostel and pursuing their education. Two wardens for each hostel and 3 residential teachers are there to take care of the children. The day starts with prayer, yoga, cleaning and followed by study hour. Special attention is given to children needing special coaching. Indoor and outdoor games, music, farming, tailoring, hill trekking, computer education are some of the special initiatives. Nutritional balanced organic diet is served at both hostels. ISS Siddha doctor visits the hostels weekly and provides health education and need based treatments. Herbal medicines produced by the Siddha Unit - bathing powder, hair oil, tooth powder, joint pain oil, skin care oil,

headache oil and crack cream are provided to the students on a monthly basis as required. ISS President, correspondence and board members visit the hostels regularly and provide value education to the children and also monitor the activities of the hostel.

Created by Mother Lea Pravo under the name Genetic Garden with the aim of identifying and conserving rare species and endangered plants throughout the Kadavur hills in the Toppaiya Sami Range that surrounds Sevapur. It has been operating since 1994 by the World Wildlife Fund through Belinda with the assistance of Belgium since 2010. The garden was developed and operated on 5 acres of land. Of these, 251 species of rare and endangered plants are protected.

Farm maintenance

Siddha medicine is used by harvesting the herbal required for Siddha medicine. Water is maintained for the plants and herbs leaves required on the farm 242 meters of fence has been repaired. Balwadi & Community Center at Vinobajipuram

ISS had been running the Balwadi Vinobajipuram for the past 26 years. The children are taught storytelling, dancing, singing, enacting dramas, hand work, product identification, and writing alphabets and words. Play way method is being followed for teaching. During 2019-20, eight students were taught in the Balwadi. Children's education and health are discussed and advice is provided to the parents in the monthly meetings. Children are taught personal hygiene to manage their day to day lives healthy. They are also provided nutritious food with vegetables, cereals and millets being included in the regular diet.

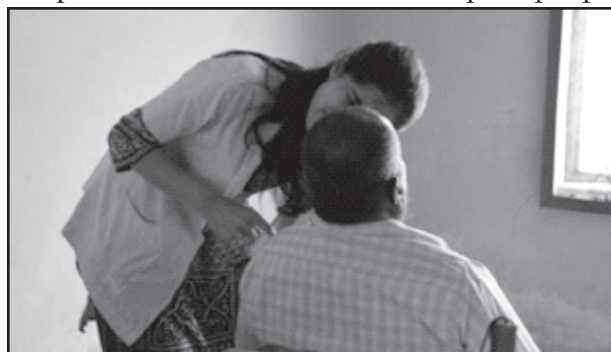

Annai Lea Provo 97th Birthday & Christmas Day Celebration

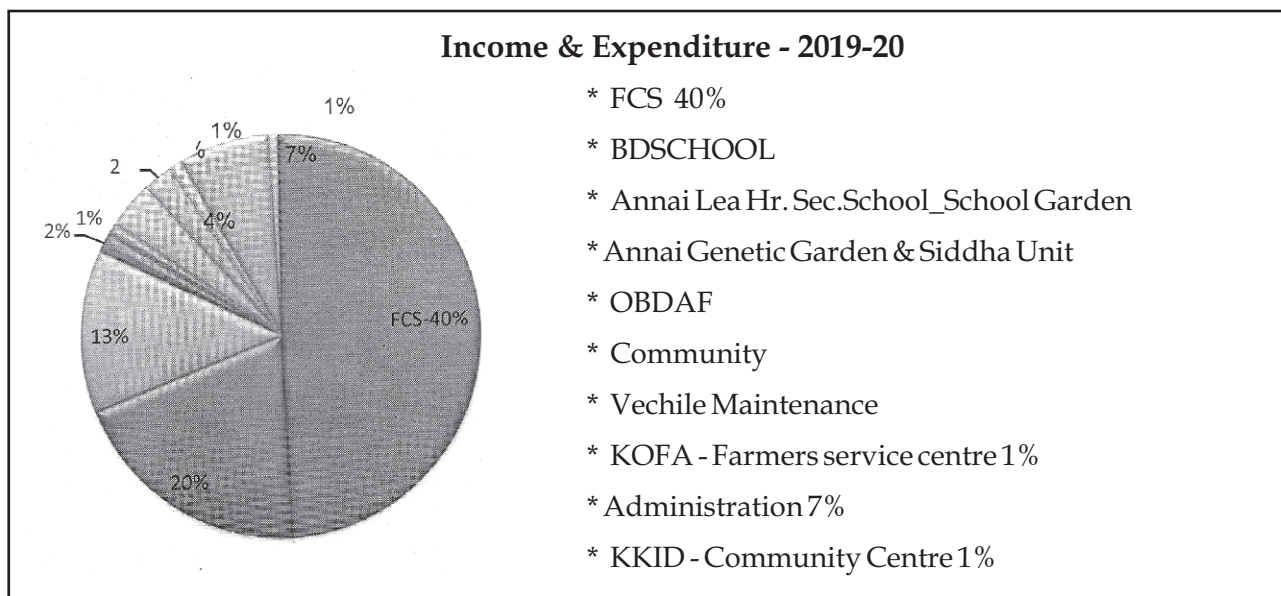

Iyarkai Nala Vazvu Muhaam

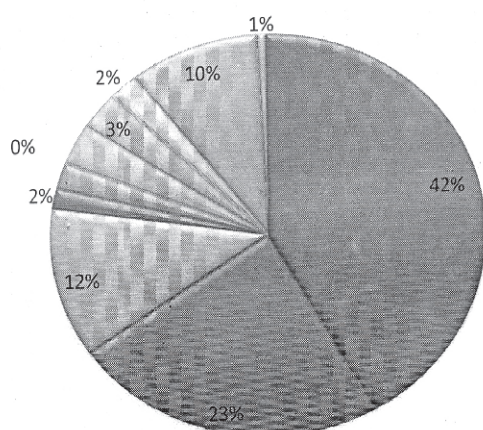

Future Plans : Development Plan-ISS Ten years Perspective Plan for Kadavur Valley Community Intervention for People

To improve the Quality of life for people with access to Health Care, Education, Markets, Financial Services and Government Schemes.

For Villages:

Villages to stand out as model communities having greater control over their lives and livelihoods. Villages which are ecologically well managed by the communities through efficient local governance.

As a first step, ISS would like to establish all required facilities in the two model villages' namely Sevapur and Vinobaji- puram established by Mother Lea Provo and proceed to all the adjoining villages.

Based on the current and immediate needs in the 2 villages created by ISS the following specific action plans are being actively considered and will be implemented in cooperation with like minded organisations in India with a funding support from State/Central Government departments in India and or

International agencies during the next 10 years from 2019 to 2029.

1. Holistic Life Centred Education to the underprivileged rural children (about 300 Students) is being taught by Inba Seva Sangam since 2003 and now requires a full-fledged affiliation for the school with a financial assistance from the state and or Central Government.
2. Healing the earth and Water Shed Management for dry and farming systems and strengthening local governance. Most of the beneficiaries in this region are resource poor small and marginal farmers dependent on dry land agriculture activities and require agriculture based small scale industries in order to get additional employment opportunity and Organic and Biodynamic Agriculture College / Institute in this rural setting. We have been processing our application for affiliation for conducting diploma institute on organic and biodynamic farming from Tamil Nadu Agriculture University (TNAU Coimbatore) and also Annamalai University Cuddalore since 2017.
3. Promoting and advocating Yoga, Spiritual Meditation, Naturopathy and Organic way of living Since its inception Inba Seva Sangam is promoting and advocating Yoga, Spiritual Meditation, Naturopathy and Organic way of living - Environmental well being among children and general public in rural areas. Hence we need to establish a centre for Yoga, Meditation and Naturopathy in rural setting in Kadavur valley.
4. Dignity of life for the Boomidan beneficiaries : Most of our farmers have received their respective farmlands from Tamil Nadu Bhoodan Board represented by Inba Seva

Sangam. Till date more than 60% of the beneficiaries are yet to get land entitlement documents like Bhoomidanum Pattharum or Patta from the revenue department of Government of Tamil Nadu. Release of the Boomindanum Pattharum will allow them to lead a dignified life as proud owners of the land.

5. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan : Strengthening local governance and village development in cooperation with government department in order to ensure at least employment opportunity for 1 person per family from these region (Textile Park). Promote Gandhian approaches in establishing decentralised small rural industries on non conventional energy resource utilising wind and solar energies and establish various energy park in rural area. A government sponsored institute or programme for establishment of watershed management and also solid waste management utilising the local available solid wastes (Swach Bharat Abhiyan Scheme)
6. An action plan through biotechnological approaches on a forestation, regeneration and conservation of endangered multi utility flora in Thoppiyasamy reserve forest sustainable formulation, popularization of endangered plants and herbal products among forest dependent local communities.
7. Diets for a Green Planet (DGP) scheme in Rural Schools : Rural children studying in school and college are mostly under/ malnourished and also unaware of consuming good nutritious balanced and organic foods. Hence Inba Seva Sangam will improve nutrition and food security among 1400 children from 15 schools in the Kadavur valley to ensure their rights to lead a healthy life by following the principles of Diets for a

Green Planet (DGP). Improve nutrition and food security of rural school children in the Kadavur valley to ensure their right to lead a healthy life.
